## Town of Westernport Special Council Meeting July 7, 2021

COMMISSIONERS PRESENT: Sarah Llewellyn, Judy Hamilton and Allen Shapiro

Mayor Laura Freeman-Legge opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Freeman-Legge brought up RESOLUTION 7.7.2021. This is a RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF WESTERNPORT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN TO PARTICIPATE IN THE MARYLAND CIRCUIT RIDER/TOWN MANAGER-PROGRAM. Among other stipulations, it is resoled that the Mayor and Commissioners of the Town of Westernport will enter into the Circuit Rider/Town Manager Program for Fiscal Years 2022-24 beginning July 1, 2022 and ending December 31, 2024. The Town will also provide a space for the Circuit Rider to work and use of utilities in an office environment totaling \$85 per week. The agreement is for 12 hours per week. The mayor asked for a motion to approve. Commissioner Shapiro made the motion to approve RESOLUTION 7.7.2021 with a second from Commissioner Llewellyn. Motion carried.

The mayor brought up RESOLUTION 7.7.2021-A. This is a resolution pertaining to the Strategic Demolition Fund from the Department of Housing. The town is applying for \$223,025 to tear down 327 and 329 Maryland Avenue. The mayor stated that she needs the authority to sign any authorization forms and to accept this resolution. Commissioner Hamilton made the motion that Mayor Laura Freeman-Legge has the authority to sign all forms regarding the Town requesting Strategic Demolition Funds from the Department of Housing and to approve RESOLUTION 7.7.2021-A. She received a second from Commissioner Llewellyn. Motion carried.

A motion to adjourn was made by Commissioner Shapiro with a second from Commissioner Llewellyn. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned.
